



A guide to joining in the Year Six Music Project Our Lady of the Rosary

Thank you for joining us in our Year Six Music Project. Firstly, I would like to record the music track with your voices and we can then move onto our leavers video. I really hope you will have fun and that you enjoy the results.

We have chosen the song "The Climb". I would like you record the full song and I can edit sections for our finished music project. Please join in as it will be a great memento to look back at in the future.

Please don't be embarrassed by recording your part. It will be mixed in with everyone else and will sound like a regular choir singing. However, in order for it to work, we do need to have everyone singing together and in the same key which is why we need a backing track.

Recording your part is not that hard if you follow the steps below. If it doesn't work perfectly, please don't worry... send me your recording and I'll do what I can with it. Ideally, it is better if we can't hear the backing track in your recording but it's OK if it is there quietly in the background.

You can record as many times as you want...on your own or with someone. You should have 2 devices, one to play the backing track and one to record on. The way most people do it is to listen on your phone and record on either another phone or a laptop/tablet.

1. Open the voice recorder on your recording device and when you are ready, press record.
2. Listen to the backing track on your phone either with earphones plugged in (works best if you only have one ear-piece in so that you can hear your voice) or with the phone against your ear.
3. Don't worry if there's a bit of a gap before you start actually singing, I can trim everything at my end.
4. When You've finished and are happy, send me the recording. You can send it to Myself and Mrs Waite to the following email: c.bourdiec910.@durhamlearning.net
